Cooperation – Tips for teaching at home

Cooperation occurs when we combine our energies to work with others toward a common goal. With cooperation we can accomplish tasks more quickly than by ourselves. It also gives us a chance to get to know one another and build friendships.

As children discover ways to cooperate with one another, they will find that working together can be exciting and rewarding. There are opportunities to work together every day.

- Create opportunities for children to cooperate. Cooking with your kids is a fun way to divide work and practice skills. Assign roles to each child such as measuring the flour, counting the correct number of eggs, pouring the milk, greasing the pan, and stirring. Everyone will have to wait their turn, follow directions, and share responsibility for creating something they can enjoy later.
- Encourage children to ask peers for help. Role play situations that require cooperation and have children discuss good choices.
- Provide opportunity to practice. Chores are a good place to start when teaching cooperation at home. Have siblings sort the laundry into lights and darks or ask them to help put the groceries away. You can also establish a family game nigh, which will naturally lend itself to determining teams, resolving conflicts, and cooperating.

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
In honor of their weekly theme "All About Me", our Manatee students were encouraged to create their face using different shapes.
